RECYCLABLE ITEMS	LANDFILL	COMPOSTABLES
<p><i>Contains no liquids &amp; little food residue</i></p> <p><b>PLASTICS</b> <i>*Please keep plastic caps on bottle/jugs</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Plastics numbered 1-7 (no PLA)</li> <li>Soda, juice, &amp; water bottles*</li> <li>Milk &amp; water jugs*</li> <li>Detergent jug*</li> <li>Plastic containers</li> <li>Plastic toys, crates, gardening trays, etc.</li> <li>Plastic bags, dry cleaning bags, &amp; clean cellophane</li> <li>Foam (only clean, dry, and not used for food)</li> </ul> <p><b>METALS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Aluminum foil &amp; pie tins (clean)</li> <li>Empty aerosol cans</li> <li>Scrap metal</li> <li>Steel cans, dishware, etc.</li> <li>Tin &amp; aluminum cans</li> </ul> <p><b>PAPER (clean &amp; dry)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Aseptic drink &amp; box soup container</li> <li>Egg cartons (paper only &amp; clean)</li> <li>Envelopes</li> <li>File folders (paper only)</li> <li>Junk mail</li> <li>Magazines</li> <li>Milk &amp; juice cartons</li> <li>Newspaper</li> <li>Paper (white &amp; mixed color)</li> <li>Paper grocery bags</li> <li>Telephone books</li> </ul>  <p><b>CARDBOARD (or similar)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cardboard &amp; corrugated boxes</li> <li>Cereal boxes</li> <li>Frozen food boxes</li> <li>Pizza boxes (clean parts)</li> </ul> <p><b>GLASS (*No window glass, porcelain, or non-food related glass)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Amber, green, &amp; mixed-color glass</li> <li>Clear food glass jars</li> <li>Soda, tea, &amp; liquor bottles</li> </ul>	<p><b>FOOD WRAPPERS/CONTAINERS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Candy &amp; protein bar wrapper</li> <li>Chip bags</li> <li>Disposal coffee cup &amp; lid</li> <li>Juice pouch</li> <li>Bags with a mix of metal &amp; plastic</li> </ul> <p><b>GLASS/PORCELAIN</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dishware</li> <li>Flower pots</li> <li>Incandescent light bulbs</li> <li>Porcelain</li> <li>Vases &amp; glass figurines</li> <li>Window glass</li> </ul>  <p><b>PAPER</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bathroom &amp; facial tissue</li> <li>Gift wrap with plastic or metal</li> <li>Hardback books</li> <li>Laminated or plastic coated paper</li> <li>Padded or Tyvec-type envelopes</li> <li>Photographs</li> </ul> <p><b>PLASTICS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Garden hoses &amp; plastic tarps</li> <li>Bubble wrap</li> </ul> <p><b>MISC</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Disposable Diapers</li> <li>Pet waste</li> <li>Unusable clothing &amp; fabric</li> </ul> <p><b>ORGANICS &amp; SOILED PAPER*</b> <i>*Only if there is no organics/food scrap collection. Please see list to right for details.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Includes all food scraps, green waste, &amp; food-soiled paper.</li> </ul>	<p><b>GREEN WASTE:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Grass clippings</li> <li>Flower &amp; hedge trimmings</li> <li>Leaves &amp; branches</li> <li>Lumber, scrap wood, &amp;</li> <li>Plywood types (not painted or treated)</li> <li>Weeds</li> </ul> <p><b>FOOD SCRAPS:</b> <i>*Any putrescible matter produced from human or animal food production, preparation, &amp; consumption activities</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bread, rice, &amp; pasta</li> <li>Cheese &amp; dairy</li> <li>Coffee filters &amp; tea bags</li> <li>Flowers &amp; herbs</li> <li>Fruits &amp; vegetables</li> <li>Meat, bones, poultry, &amp; seafood</li> </ul> <p><b>FOOD-SOILED PAPER</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Compostable to-go containers/ serving-ware: must be <b>100% fiber based</b>.</li> <li>Egg cartons (paper)</li> <li>Food-stained paper</li> <li>Napkins &amp; kitchen towels</li> <li>Paper food boats (no plastic lining)</li> <li>Paper packaging</li> <li>Paper plates &amp; cups</li> <li>Pizza boxes</li> </ul> <p><i>*No bathroom tissue, toilet paper, or feminine products.</i></p> <p><i>We only accept specific compostable "bio-plastic" material. For approval of such items, please contact Athens Services.</i></p>

## Workshop/Painting Supplies

- Adhesives & glues
